## WHAT IS ADIL?

It is a premier adult learning programme specially tailored for adult Muslim learners in Singapore. It is derived from the Arabic word 'Adil which literally means a just person. Allah s.w.t. commands Muslims to be bearers of justice for it is closest to Taqwa (God-consciousness).

"Be just, this is closest to Taqwa," [Al-Ma'idah 5:8]

ADIL symbolizes maturity, moderation, rationality and objectivity. It represents a learned individual who is inclusive; transcends religion, race, language or other forms of denominators. This programme is designed to be relevant and suited for our Muslim adults' contemporary spiritual and intellectual needs. The programme is offered in both Malay and English to cater to varied demands and needs of the Muslim community.

#### **Structured Learning**

#### **ADIL SELF-PACED E-LEARNING MODULE**







#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I am just starting to learn the religion, where should i start? We recommend you to begin with the modules as they cover the foundational aspects of Islam. Hence, you may consider AY Centres that offer these modules first.

#### What is the difference on the sets of modules?

The only difference is the arrangement of the modules. Ultimately, all the modules will be covered within the span of 2 years.

#### How do I register for the ADIL AY program?

You may go to learnislam.sg and click on your preferred AY Centre to make registration.

## Why do different AY Centres arrange their modules differently?

The sets are arranged differently to provide you flexibility and options to pick, especially for AY Centres within the same mosque district.

## How is ADIL AY different from the Centres that offer single modules?

ADIL AY covers all core and elective in 2 years on a weekly basis. Whereas single modules are short term and will be only offered on an ad-hoc basis.

## Can I join the program midway if i missed the registration in January?

Yes you may do so, but do note that you will miss the earlier sessions. Nevertheless, you may still enrol in the missed modules when an ADIL Centre offers it separately as a modular class.

## Can I change AY Centres? Or choose to only attend one module?

Yes you may do so. Please refer to your respective AY Centre for more details.

#### Are there any refund policies for withdrawals?

No, there are no refund policies for withdrawals as the program fee is paid monthly and not annually.

#### How will I be notified of my confirmation?

The AY Centre that you have registered with will notify you on the confirmation.

#### Will I receive a certificate and further my studies with it?

Participants who complete the whole program will receive a certificate of completion by the mosque. Currently, it is an endorsement of the completion but cannot be used for furthering of studies.
