HADITH ON DU'A WHEN LEAVING HOME

Narrated Anas ibn Malik:

The Prophet (ﷺ) said: When a man goes out of his house and says: "In the name of Allah I have placed my trust, and there is no might and no power except by Allah," the following will be said to him at that time: "You are guided, defended and protected." The devils will go far from him and another devil will say: How can you deal with a man who has been guided, defended and protected?

Benefit of Reciting Morning and Evening Zikir

Morning and Evening Zikir are the supplications that are recited daily after Fajr prayer (before sunrise) and after Asar prayer (before sunset). If we need ease, protection, and facilitation in everything we do, we should always remember to recite the following supplications which are from the Quran and Sunnah of Prophet Muhammad s.a.w.

DU'A DURING ASSEMBLY

Step 1: Begin with Salam

Step 2: Recite Surah al-Fatihah

Step 3: Du'a entering the Mosque

Oh Allah! open for me the doors of your mercy

Step 4: Du'a seeking knowledge

رَبِّ زِدْنِي عِلْمًا، وَارْزُقْنِي فَهْمًا

Rabbi Zidni Ilman, Warzuqni Fahman

Oh Allah! Increase my knowledge and grant me understanding

Benefit of Du'a seeking knowledge

Reciting the Du'a "**Rabbi Zidni Ilma**" can be beneficial in improving your mental abilities and increasing your understanding of Islamic and worldly knowledge. This practice can help you gain a deeper awareness and consciousness of various subjects, allowing you to expand your knowledge.

DU'A DURING ASSEMBLY

Step 5: Recite Selawat upon Beloved Prophet Muhammad s.a.w

Sollallahu ala Muhammad
Sollallahu alaihi Wasallam

May Allah bless honour upon Prophet Muhammad
May Allah honour him and grant him peace

Food for thought

Reciting Selawat is a sign of our love for him. It is also part of our daily Zikir (remembrance) that will purify and strengthen us spiritually. Regular Selawat must not be absent from the daily routine of a person who claims to love the Prophet because reciting the Selawat is a very simple act. It can be done almost anywhere and at any time - whether a person is walking, waiting for the bus, in the MRT or when taking a break.

Food for thought

Prophet Muhammad s.a.w made spreading Salam as part of faith. Salam sows seeds of love and friendship in the hearts of Muslims. Prophet Muhammad s.a.w commanded us to return Salam and made it a right and a duty.

Why do we recite Du'a before a meal?

When Prophet Muhammad s.a.w was blessed with food, he praised Allah s.w.t and acknowledged the blessings given. He taught us to recite the Name of Allah s.w.t at the beginning of every pleasant task or deed, including eating.

Praise be to Allah who has provided us with food

Food for thought

Du'a after eating is a way of thanking Allah for the food that has been consumed. According to Muslim.Sg, reciting the dua after eating has several benefits

1. It is a way of expressing gratitude to Allah for providing food.
2. It helps to remove any sins committed during the meal.
3. It helps to increase the blessings of the food consumed.

Did you know?

Our beloved Prophet Muhammad s.a.w taught us that we should put our left foot first before entering the toilet and recite Du'a.

Did you know?

Muslims are advised not to linger in the toilet for long and must immediately leave the toilet when all our activities in it are finished by stepping with the right foot when leaving the toilet door and also recite Du'a

wallahu akbar

Praise be to Allah and Thanks be to Allah and
there is no God but Allah and Allah is The
Greatest

Why do we perform Zikir?

- Keeping away the Syaitan and weakening his strength
- Relieving the mind from anxieties and worries
- Producing joy and happiness in the heart
- Strengthening the body and mind

DU'A AFTER SOLAT

Step 1: Recite Surah al-Fatihah

Step 2: Du'a for our Parents

Rabbighfiri Waliwalidayya Warhamhuma Kama
Rabbayani Soghira

O my Lord! Forgive me and my parents, and
bestow Your Mercy upon them both, as they
brought me up when I was young

Did you know?

One of the most important Du'a in Islam is the Du'a for parents. To perform this Du'a, simply recite the above verse with sincerity and conviction. It is recommended to perform this Du'a after every prayer, as well as at other times throughout the day. Additionally, it is important to be kind, respectful, and obedient to your parents as an act of gratitude for all they have done for you.

DU'A AFTER SOLAT

Step 3: Du'a for this life and the Hereafter

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الآخِرَةِ
حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

Rabbana atina fid dunya hasanatan wa fil
Aakhirati hasanatan waqina 'azab an-nar

Our Lord, give us in this world [that which is] good
and in the Hereafter [that which is] good and
protect us from the punishment of the Fire.

The Miracle of Quran

Rabbana Atina Fid Dunya Hasanah is one of the most comprehensive Du'a -supplication- that includes every matter that a Muslim may need in life and hereafter. What is special about Rabbana Atina Du'a is that is quoted from Al-Quran in Surah Al-Baqarah, verse 201 and there is nothing greater than the Words of Allah.
